3C Hwaam Cave | Natural Monument No. 557

This was previously part of Cheonpo Mine where gold was mined. A themed cave was created using the limestone cave discovered while mining the gold and the gold mine pits. Hwaam Cave has both a gold mine and a natural limestone cave. You can learn about the history and development of the mine and view the natural limestone cave.

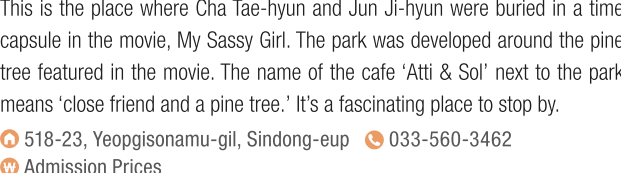
3C TV Show Three Meals a Day <Daechon Village, Deogu-ri>
